SAIGON TO PHNOM PENH - 3 NIGHTS

The Mekong is a river of stories, flowing from the lively streets of Vietnam to the calm, rural landscapes of Cambodia. New for 2026, this three-night upstream river cruise offers an easy city-to-city connection between Saigon and Phnom Penh, giving you a relaxing, slow paced Mekong experience without needing a full week away.

Aboard the RV Tonle Pandaw, you'll drift by sampan through Ben Tre's mangrove forests, pause at small fruit orchards, see floating fish farms near Chau Doc, and take in sweeping river views from Sam Mountain. Travelers looking for added comfort also have the option to upgrade to the Tonle Suites, offering double the space of a traditional cabin and a more private, luxury filled onboard experience.

Designed for those who still want to pack in lots of scenery in a short timeframe, this journey blends nature, culture, and the gentle pace of river life to add a standout experience to your Southeast Asia travels.

ITINERARY UPSTREAM



DAY 1 FROM SAIGON TO THE DELTA

Embark your Pandaw vessel in central Saigon and relax on the spacious sundeck as we set sail past the towering skyscrapers of Vietnam's bustling metropolis. After lunch onboard you will meet the crew and enjoy local entertainment on the deck as we sail toward the Mekong Delta. We moor overnight on the Vam Co River.



DAY 2 BEN TRE AND THE FERTILE WATERWAYS

Early morning we set sail through the Cho Gao Canal, a vital waterway link for the transportation of goods to and from the city which was constructed in 1876 by the French and offers a fascinating insight to life along the water. We reach Ben Tre and journey by sampans through mangroves and bamboo forests to the fruit orchards abundant in the area. This is a fertile farming region with half of Vietnam's rice production coming from the Mekong Delta. It also hosts a rich artisanal culture which we will witness at a local village specialising in handicrafts. Back aboard we sail deeper into the delta toward Chau Doc.



DAY 3 CHAU DOC AND INTO CAMBODIA

In the morning, we take minivans for a short drive to Sam Mountain, the location of Phuoc Dien Tu or the Hang Pagoda. After climbing the steps we are greeted with stunning views across the Mekong. For those not keen on the stairs, explore the local market instead. Afterwards, we visit the nearby floating fish farms by Sampan before being treated to a private Lion dance performance at a local Village. Upon return to the ship, we navigate a web of canals before dropping anchor on the Vietnam/Cambodia border to undergo Immigration formalities.



Note: During high water periods in October and November, navigation into Chau Doc may be hampered by low bridges meaning today's excursion will be replaced with a local village visit at Long Thuan.



DAY 4 PHNOM PENH DISEMBARKATION

After breakfast, disembark your Pandaw in Cambodia's capital Phnom Penh.

DAY 1 FROM SAIGON TO THE DELTA

Meeting point for embarkation in Saigon will be the Hotel des Arts Saigon - MGallery Collection (76-78 Nguyen Thi Minh Khai, Xuan Hoa Ward, Ho Chi Minh City) and registration will be at 11:00 AM. Shared bus will leave at 11:30 AM.

Dock address: Cruise Passenger Port, No. 05 Nguyen Tat Thanh Street, Xom Chieu Ward, Ho Chi Minh City.

Please Note: your cabin may not be available until after lunch. If you have your own transfer directly to the Saigon port, please inform us.

DAY 4 PHNOM PENH DISEMBARKATION

Disembark after breakfast an immigration formalities have finished (around 10:30am) at the Phnom Penh Autonomous Port, #649, Preah Sisowath Street, Sras Chork Commune, Phnom Penh.

PANDAW STATEROOMS

The Pandaw stateroom is the most celebrated feature of our ships, combining splendid colonial-era character with exquisite contemporary comfort.

Finished in brass and teak, the main and upper deck rooms are a spacious 168 square feet (15.6 sqm), with the exception of the RV Kindat Pandaw which is 150 square feet (14 sqm). As the space is much loved by all our passengers, we have ensured that with each ship we build, the stateroom remains essentially the same. Be advised: our cabins do not have mini-bars, satellite TV's, internet access or telephones. Passengers tend to choose Pandaw in order to escape from the tiresome features found in international business hotels.

The price includes drinks, wine and main meals and snacks. Meals can be served at tables for two or more in the dining room, on deck, or in your suite. Our executive chef has worked in Michelin starred restaurants and has created fusion menus using sustainable locally sourced foods.

There has been an increasing demand for top-end suites and no ship could be more perfect for this creation than the splendid Tonle Pandaw, originally built in Myanmar and fitted out with pure Burmah teak which

repurposed for construction of the new suites. A newly fitted out spa will be a popular feature in addition to the gym, library, cocktail saloon and extensive open deck areas associated with much loved Pandaw ships.

Starting in Saigon city port, travellers will spend three days crossing the great Vietnamese Mekong Delta and then exploring the Mekong and Tonle rivers in Cambodia ending at Angkor Wat. Excursions with expert guides by sampan, cyclo or tuk tuk and cultural entertainments on board are a feature of any cruise.

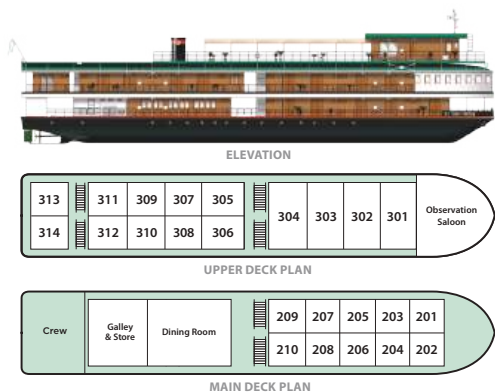


PANDAW SHIPS

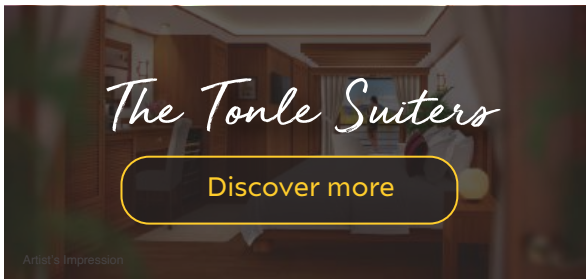
RV Tonle Pandaw

Finished in rich teak and brass, the RV Tonle Pandaw recently went a retrofit in 2025 upgrading the guest accommodations to offer four luxury cabins spanning over 40 square meters. Now sailing along the Classic Mekong route, the ship features a total of X staterooms along with the famous Pandaw upper deck saloon, observation decks, and a formal dining room. This ship is an old favourite and has a glowing ambience complete with a professional spa and library on the lower deck. Despite being one of the larger ships in our fleet, the RV Tonle Pandaw has an ultra-shallow draft of just over a meter and can usually get up river into low water areas when other vessels are stuck well below.

DAY 1 ARRIVAL IN HUE

Welcome to Vietnam. After arrival at Hue Airport meet your guide and driver for the transfer to your hotel. Rest of day at leisure.

DAY 2 HUE

Embark on a guided journey through Hue's captivating past and present by car. This morning, we'll immerse ourselves in the vibrant atmosphere of Dong Ba Market, a bustling commercial center teeming with local life and traditional goods since the 19th century. Next, find tranquility at the iconic Linh Mu Pagoda, a seven-story Buddhist temple dating back to 1601, renowned for its intricate architecture and serene ambiance. We'll then delve into the grandeur of the Nguyen Dynasty with a visit to the impressive tomb of Emperor Tu Duc, surrounded by a beautiful royal garden, arriving by car. Savor a delicious royal-style lunch at a local restaurant before exploring the historic Hue Citadel, including the Noon Gate, Thai Hoa Palace, Royal Urns, and the ruins of the Forbidden Purple City. This afternoon promises an unforgettable immersion in Vietnam's imperial heritage.

DAY 3 HUE - HOI AN

After breakfast we leave Hue for Hoian. En route we pause to unwind on top of the Ocean Clouds Pass, on the Non Nuoc Beach and then visit the fascinating Cham Museum. We then proceed to the quaint town of Hoian for check in and to relax. In the afternoon, there is time to explore this charming and wonderfully preserved merchant town that retains Chinese, Japanese, Vietnamese and European influences from its flourishing old days.

DAY 4 HOI AN

Day at leisure. Explore the beautiful old town of Hoi An or relax at the beach.

DAY 5 HOI AN - DANANG - SAIGON

Transfer to the airport for a flight from Danang 08.00 to Saigon 09.25 (flight times subject to change). Upon arrival, drive to the extraordinary Cu Chi tunnels, about 65 Km (1½ hours' drive) from Saigon. This complicated underground network was built by Viet Cong guerillas. En route, you have the chance to see how rural people live and work such as cashew nut farming, duck breeding, rice farming and production of rice paper, a key ingredient in Vietnamese cuisine. After lunch in a local restaurant, return to Saigon. In the afternoon, visit to Reunification Hall, Notre Dame Cathedral, General Post Office, Former US Embassy, City Hall, War Museum of Remnants. Shopping at Ben Thanh market.

DAY 6 SAIGON DEPARTURE

Morning at leisure. Transfer with your fellow Pandaw passengers to embark your ship.

Silk Path Grand Hue

Hue is unlike anywhere else in the country. Tree-lined streets branch from the winding Perfume River. Tombs and temples lay embedded in the countryside. River Conditions Warning!

The rivers you will sail on are subject to seasonal rises and falls of water level, in some places as much as 30 metres. Water levels can change dramatically overnight and a sudden rise can impede our progress upstream considerably and even prevent us from passing under certain bridges. A sudden fall can result in our being unable to get into certain places or go as far upstream as we would hope. Groundings on sandbars are not infrequent and are part of the excitement of any Pandaw expedition. Published itineraries are indicational only and subject to sudden change. In such events alternative itineraries will be provided and we do our best to ensure that if a stop is missed we make up for it with another stop. Passengers are thus forewarned and expected to be flexible and patient. River cruising in Asia can be a dramatic and adventurous experience - not like cruising the controlled waterways of Europe or America. Note also that we operate in areas with little or no developed infrastructure and subject to the strictures of local officialdom. Be prepared for this and it is all more the fun!
